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## STATEMENT OF SENATOR BLUMENTHAL

- 2 Senator Blumenthal. Well, I have put a hold on these
- 3 nominees because I feel that the firings that have occurred,
- 4 the freezes on hiring, and the cuts in funding have not been
- 5 justified. They have impacted the VA in ways that we're
- 6 hearing from our constituents.
- 7 We were all assured by the Secretary it would not
- 8 happen. We've received no responses to the inquiries we've
- 9 been making about why it's happening, and what the strategy
- 10 and the plan is. And so, I will oppose these nominees.
- 11 Chairman Moran. I was trying to get Senator Murray to
- 12 hold you to the same standard that she was holding me, and
- 13 you did it on your own.
