(c) Accessibility.—The Secretary shall ensure that
each of the programs under subsection (b) are accessible
for veterans with paralysis, a spinal cord injury or dis-
order, or another disability, consistent with applicable ac-
cessibility requirements.
(d) Rule of Construction.—Nothing in this sec-
tion or the amendments made by this section shall prevent
the Secretary of Veterans Affairs from expanding tele-
screening mammography services to facilities of the De-
partment that are not—
(1) the facilities participating in the pilot pro-
gram under section 102 of the Making Advances in
Mammography and Medical Options for Veterans
Act (Public Law 117–135; 38 U.S.C. 7322 note) as
of the day before the date of the enactment of this
Act; or
(2) located in States where the Department
does not offer breast imaging services at a facility
